As in previous years, subscription tickets are not available in Huddersfield Town Hall Gallery and subscribers choosing to sit in the Area should note that individual seats cannot be reserved. For subscribers choosing Balcony/Balcony Window seats, please use the seating plan included to indicate your preferred seats. Complete the booking form as detailed and return it, with your remittance and s.a.e. to the Ticket and Subscriber Secretary no later than 16 September 2022. Your tickets will be despatched to you as soon as possible after that date. Late applications will have reduced choice of seats.

**Subscription** for five concerts, three in Huddersfield Town Hall and two in Huddersfield Parish Church (all seats unreserved in the Parish Church) and saving 20% for the season.

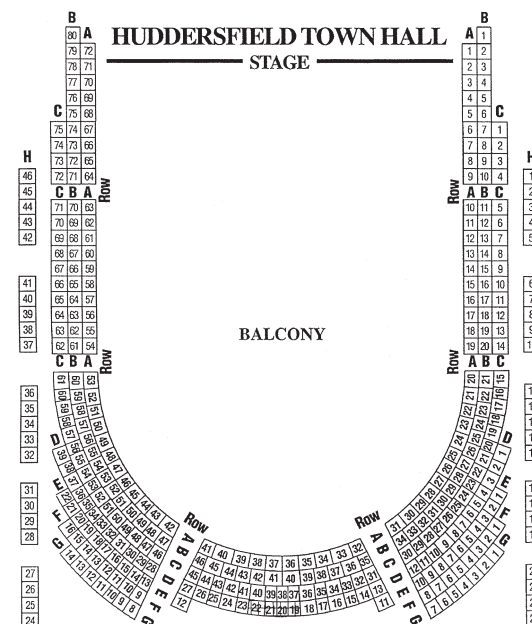
